How to Start Writing an APA-Style Paper

General APA Guidelines. Your essay should be typed and double-spaced on standard-sized paper (8.5" x 11"), with 1" margins on all sides. Include a page header (also known as the " running head ") at the top of every page. For a professional paper, this includes your paper title and the page number.

The APA format title page for student papers includes six main components: the title of the APA format paper; names of all authors; institutional affiliation; course number and title; instructor ' s name; due date; Title pages for professional papers also require a running head; student papers do not.

The text should be typed on standard 8.5" x 11" white paper. The APA style requires using an easy-to-read font, recommending size 12, Times New Roman font. Double spacing is required on both the title page and throughout the paper. Margins should be 1" on all sides of the page.

Indentation and alignment in APA play a significant role in improving the readability of academic papers. Basically, a writer must use the correct indentation when presenting different heading levels or marking each passage ' s beginning. As a rule, each paragraph ' s first line should have a 0.5-inch indentation from the left margin.
